Herbal Medicines and Remedies
(SEE Scientific Reasoning-Laboratory)

Eligibility: 2.5 GPA

Prerequisites: ENG 150, 151 or 153 and placement into MATH 135 or above

Examines the cultural and medical aspects of Ecuadorian folk remedies. Visit traditional healers, the Tiputini Biodiversity Station in the Amazon jungle, the cloud forest, and sites of cultural and historical significance. Students will conduct experiments on herbal remedies indigenous to the area.
